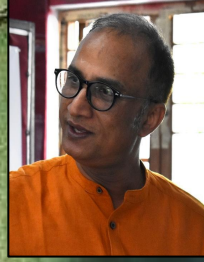

Bamboo has clear and proven potential to change the country

Bamboo is a resource of the people. Bamboo is commonly processed by the people. Wherever possible, programs for the people should include bamboo as a material - that would provide a market and kick start the bamboo economy, leading to investment, and growing, processing, and higher levels of value addition. The approach: of the people, by the people, for the people needs to be taken to mainstream bamboo. Bamboo can generate millions of jobs in rural areas and also urban areas. Currently, an estimated 9 million people are employed in the bamboo sector. This can increase several-folds. The Webinar Series is intended to review the status of bamboo-based development in the country, identify various issues and necessary interventions, and develop a strategy white paper for bamboo-based sustainable development.

Ms. Neelam Manjunath: Ar. Neelam Manjunath is an architect, planner, scientist, activist and theoretician. Ma'am has done her B.Sc, Agra University, 1982, B.Architecture, Govt. College of Architecture, Lucknow, 1987, Media Architecture and Charrette Training, GSD, Harvard University, PG Dip-Theology, DEI, Dayalbagh, Agra, Circular Economy and Sustainable Strategies, University of Cambridge Judge Business School. Her architecture is distinguished for Healing the Biosphere and well being of society. Her work has been published and presented widely. Ma'am is also the Proprietress, Manasaram Architects, 1991, CEO, Founder, CGBMT-School of Simple Living, 2004, Chair, Karnataka Chapter & NGCM, Bamboo Society of India, Advisor, Karnataka State Bamboo Mission, 2019 and Key Expert, Bamboo Construction Task Force, INBAR. Ma'am was also nominated and won Sir M Vishwesvaraya Prize (2005), IIA-Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheswara Award (2005), World Architecture Community awards, 2013, Lafarge Invention awards (2011), World Architecture News Awards (2013) and ma'am bought many awards home.



Dr. Sanjeev Singh: Dr. Sanjeev Singh is a *Professor of Architecture in Department of Architecture, School of Planning and Architecture Bhopal*. An Architecture graduate from Government College of Architecture (now Faculty of Architecture, AKTU, U.P), he completed his Master's (Environmental Studies) from Melbourne University and PhD from National University of Singapore. His research interests are in the field of *Vernacular Architecture, Cultural Landscapes, and Environmental Studies*. He has been conducting *Vernacular Studio* at SPA Bhopal since past nine years and has publications that refer to his interest areas. Presently he is also holding the position of *Dean (Planning and Development)* at SPA, Bhopal. Sir has also won awards and distinctions: Recipient of *AISAID Scholarship, 1994* by Government of Australia and Government of India, *Postgraduate Research Scholarships, 1998* by National University of Singapore, Singapore.



Mr. SPJ Narayan: Sir, S. Prithvi Jeya Narayan's native place is Tamilnadu. He has done his architecture from Mohamed sathak school of Architecture, kilakkarai, Tamilnadu. He got graduated in the year 2017. He has been running his own practice since beginning. He got his first training in bamboo in 2015. He also got trainings in Bangalore, Auroville and Arunachal pradesh. He worked with Auroville for few projects. Sir SPJ Narayan is currently developing Common Facility Centre at Balaghat to Bamboo Entrepreneurship Development Foundation.
