Dr Jayaraman Durai is currently working as the Director of Global Programme at the International Bamboo and Rattan organization (INBAR), currently based in Beijing, China. for over 15 years, Durai has helped to Design and manage Large scale Bamboo-Based Livelihood Development Programmes across Cambodia, India and the number of countries in Eastern and Southern Africa .Durai has extensive Knowledge and Expertise in Bamboo-based livelihood and Environmental Development ,capacity Building, Partnership Development, Investment Promotion and fund Raising. He holds two masters Degrees in Social work from Madras University, India and Environment Science and Policy from Clark University the USA.



Dr Jitendra Veer Sharma has nearly 34 years experience of overall Coordination and management of projects and activities in the forestry sector. He has recently conducted 2-month long Mid-Career Training Programmed for senior Indian Forest Service Officers covering various aspects of many mainstream and cross-cutting issues of forestry. Earlier he has also worked as DIG (Forest Policy and Forest International Cooperation) as link officer along with his main assignment as DIG-Research and training in the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change and dealt with various issues of research and training. He has also worked on various projects related to Economic Valuation of Forest Ecosystem, Change in Forest Governance, Carbon Financing and enhancing livelihoods of Forest communities. Presently on deputation to TERI.



Dr Promode Kant holds a PhD in Climate Change and Forestry, Masters in Physics and Masters in Forestry, and a post graduate diploma in wildlife conservation and management and has more than three-decade long experience in the IFS related to forest administration and management. He established the first tiger project KMTR in Tamil Nadu, initiated the highly successful Eco-development program around its buffer and made it into the biggest hub for field research in wildlife in India while leading it on two occasions. He has held several top positions in Tamil Nadu Forest Department both in the headquarters and also as Managing Director of the Tamil Nadu Tea Plantation Corporation, Coonoor, which is the largest tea plantation company in the public sector in India.
